ORDINANCE NO. 275

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING NOISE, ODOR, AND SAFETY AND ESTAB-LISHING REGULATIONS FOR TRUCK PARKING IN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF BROADUS, PROVIDING ENFORCEMENT PROVI-SIONS THEREFORE AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS.

The Town Council of the Town of Broadus, Montana does 6 ordain as follows;

SECTION ONE - APPLICATION

This Ordinance shall regulate the parking of trucks, truck trailers, semitrailers, horse trailers and homemade trailers.

SECTION TWO - NOISE

It shall be unlawful to park any truck or truck trailer loaded with live cattle, sheep, swine, poultry or other animals within 300 feet of any residence house in the corporate limits of the Town of Broadus between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M.

It shall be unlawful for any truck to be parked with the motor left running within 300 feet of any residence house in the corporate limits of the Town of Broadus between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M.

SECTION THREE - ODOR

It shall be unlawful to park any trucks used to haul pigs, livestock, manure, fertilizer, furs, carcasses, or other substances which emit a decerable offensive odor within 300 feet of any residence house or business establishment in the Town of Broadus for more than one (1) hour.

SECTION FOUR - SAFETY

It shall be unlawful to park any trucks hauling radioactive wastes or materials, or explosives within the corporate limits of the Town of Broadus.

No truck shall at any time park where it blocks access

to a fire hydrant, driveway, garage, private home or public business.

SECTION FIVE - EXCEPTIONS

Sections One, Two and Three shall not apply to stops required for fuel, repairs, meals or bona fide emergencies.

Section Three shall not apply to trucks used for the local delivery of fuel such as oil, gasoline, and propane.

Section Two shall not apply to livestock hauling vehicles properly parked in designated areas at county fairs, rodeos, ropings, agricultural shows, livestock auctions, and similar agricultural events.

SECTION SIX - PENALTY

Any person, agency, corporation, or business entity guilty of violation of this Ordinance shall be fined an amount up to One hundred Dollars (\$100) for each offense.

SECTION SEVEN - EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.

SECTION EIGHT - SEVERABLILITY

If any provision of this Ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, such invalidity will not affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or provisions, and to that end the provisions therefore declared to be severable.
